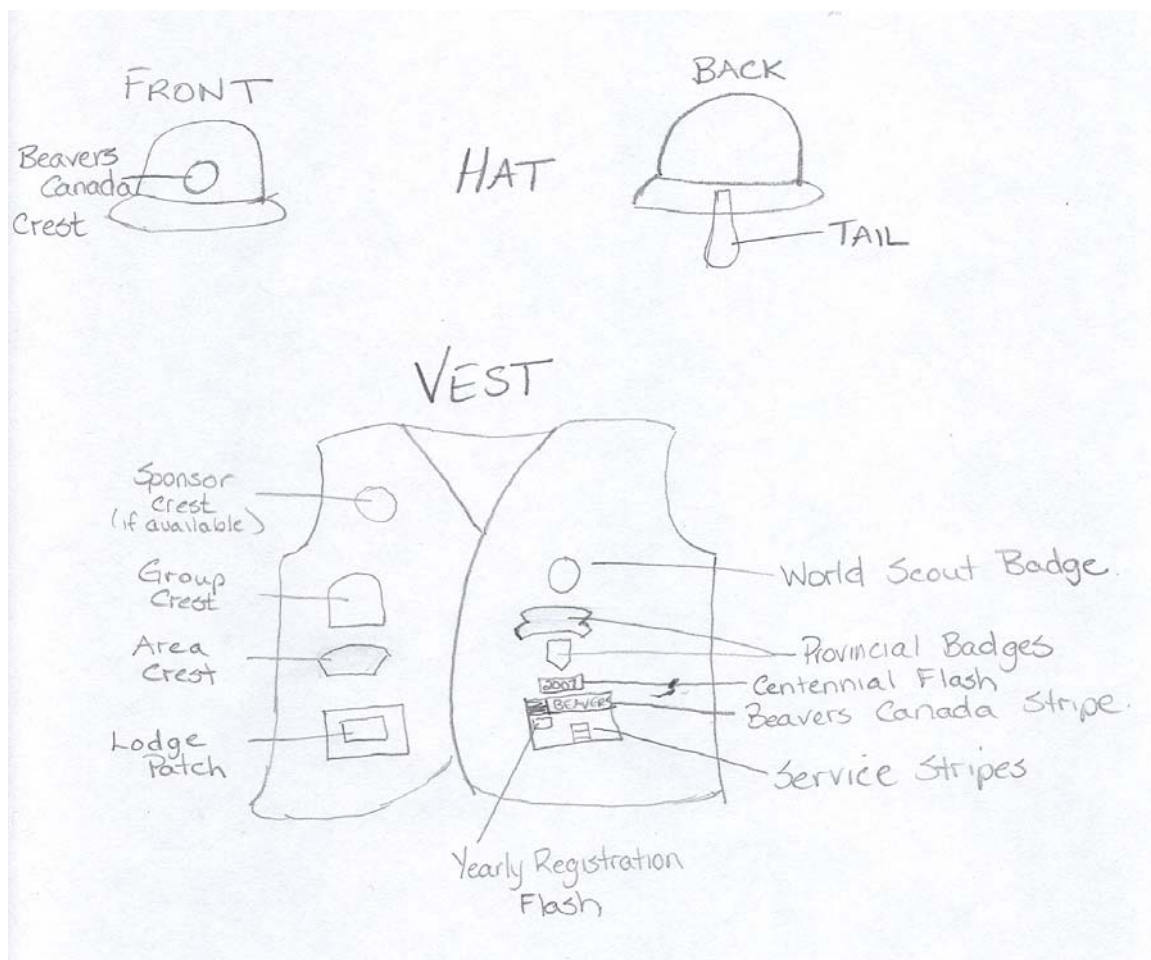


BEAVER UNIFORM

Our uniform is a very important part of the Beaver program. It tells people who we are and where we are from. It is important to take pride in your uniform and keep it in good shape. Because Scouting is an international organization, **there are places to put specific badges and crests**. It is important that only the appropriate badges/crests appear on the uniform and that they are in the correct place. The diagram below will assist you in placing the crests. Beavers will receive other badges for events and program themes. These are meant to be collected & displayed, usually on a campfire blanket. Currently, 2nd North Battleford presents each Beaver that swims up into cubs and registers in our cub program with a scouting campfire blanket. We will be making Beaver bags for the kids soon and this is a good place to display the badges until they get a blanket.

All of the badges that go on the vest are provided by the group and you will receive over the next few weeks. If you have obtained a used uniform, please make sure that the World Scouting Badge is already on the vest....those should never be removed. If it has been, please let me know and you can purchase one from the Scout Shop. (We can order that for you). If you are planning to sell your vest when you leave Beavers, remove all badges with the exception of the World Scouting Badge and transfer them to your Cub Uniform or Campfire Blanket. Remember, we are always willing to buy used uniforms.
