BADGE TESTING:

- We will be working on earning the Purple and Blue stars this year.
 - If you attend all of the meetings, you will earn the stars.
 - If you miss a meeting it will be up to you to complete the requirements that you missed.
- **To earn badges.**
 - Complete the requirements in your cub book, then
 - Bring your book in to be tested on what you have learned.
 - **Bring what you need to be tested** – e.g. If you are being tested on compass work – bring a compass.
- **Pack Specialty Badge**
 - This year, we will be working on Service for a Pack Specialty.
 - Thank you for participating in the (1) Great Canadian Shoreline Cleanup (Sept 20), or the (2) Project PorchLight night (Sept 23), (3) November 5th Meeting and (4) November 11th at the Brandt Centre.
 - Helping out at various events will count towards your pack specialty badge.
- We will TRY to **make time during most meetings** for badge testing. We will be playing this by ear especially over the first few weeks.
 - Make sure you let your leaders know at the start of a meeting if you have a badge that you would like to test for.
 - If the meeting is too busy, we may have to postpone your testing.
- If you are a sixer or seconder and you are interested in earning you **Specialty badge**, talk to your leaders about the 'Junior Leader' requirements.
 - To recognize cubs that want to help out with meetings, camps, programming and who show maturity, we will help you earn your specialty badge.

Getting to CAMPS

- Parents are responsible to get their youth to and from camp.
- Leaders will not be responsible for finding rides.
- We encourage you to carpool. Please ask – There is usually a lot of room, if you plan ahead.

ATTENDANCE

- If you are going to be late, or are not going to attend, please notify your sixer.
- Dues: \$1.00 per week, absent or present, at all meetings unless previously notified that dues are not required that week.
